## Feedback: Bilateral Meeting – 2 March 2023

### Transfers of employees to Border Management Authority (BMA)

Members will recall that consultation was undertaken through the PSCBC wherein task teams consisting of labour and employer were established. The task teams criss-crossed the country to consult affected employees although not everybody managed to attend the sessions owing to various reasons. The negotiations at the PSCBC were to pave way for the engagement at departmental and even DBC level where employees would be individually engaged.

Subsequently, a special bilateral meeting was held on 2 March 2023 where the employer presented its plan and program to issue transfer letters to affected employees at the ports of entry before the conclusion of consultation held through the PSCBC.

The employer presented a program (*attached*) where labour was requested to submit three names per union to form part of the final consultation with members at the cost of the employer as detailed.
