Unpaid benefits to CET staff

The PSA is concerned about the slow pace of paying due benefits to members employed by the Department of Higher Education and Training (CET Colleges). The PSA visited several of these Community Training Centers and discovered that many members are complaining about unpaid benefits, which include housing allowance, REQV-salary adjustments, and grade progression as per Resolution 3/2009. This is a great concern to the PSA. The PSA requests government to source funds to increase the number of working hours to seven for Lecturers as the current hours are not sufficient to cover the syllabus, which is a major concern for learners who are greatly disadvantaged.
