Update: GPSSBC Departmental Bargaining Chamber for the Department of Trade, Industry, and Competition

Fit for Purpose

The PSA has invoked *clause* 17 of the Governance Rules for Chambers which requires the Secretary General of the Council to convene facilitation between parties to clear a deadlock. The employer has postponed the long-requested special Chamber meeting countlessly owing to the unavailability of the Deputy Director General who is supposed to engage labour on the matter of fit for purpose. While the employer refuses to engage, the PSA continues to receive reports from members that their roles are being affected directly and indirectly by the unilateral implementation of this restructuring project. The PSA will be exploring all legal avenues at its disposal to challenge the employer on this matter. Members are advised to not accept changes to their role profiles or changes to terms and conditions of their employment without the assistance of the PSA as this process is unprocedural.

Exit Trends

The employer presented an update on exit trends in the DTIC for the period 1 April 2023 to 30 June 2023. According to the employer's analysis of grievances and exits, there was no direct correlation found between the grievances lodged and exit interview findings. Most exist as a result of personal reasons. Two employees went on retirement, six employees were transferred out of the DTIC and 18 employees resigned. Amongst those who have been terminated, five of them were senior managers and 21 were below senior management. The PSA's interest in monitoring exit trends is to assess and ensure that employees are not resigning from the Department due to unfair treatment and grievances that can be resolved or prevented.
