## Request for urgent mandate: Draft Special Leave Sectoral Agreement

### Draft Special Leave Sectoral Agreement

The previous edition of the PSA's *Informus* refers. Members were in the last *Informus* requested to provide the PSA with input regarding a draft special leave sectoral agreement (Copy of previous editions of the *Informus* is available on the PSA's website ([www.psa.co.za](http://www.psa.co.za)) or from PSA Provincial Offices). Following inputs received from members, the draft agreement was subjected to a negotiation process and some of the inputs were incorporated. The negotiation process was concluded and the employer and one of the recognised unions signed the agreement.

Members' mandate is crucial in assisting the PSA to determine whether to accept or reject the draft collective agreement. The PSA commits to signing the agreement only when the majority of members have given the necessary mandate to the Union. Members are requested to provide their mandate by completing the *attached* mandate form and submitting it through their respective PSA Provincial Offices to [Velucia.maluleke@psa.co.za](mailto:Velucia.maluleke@psa.co.za) **by no later than 25 November 2023**. Members' prompt response will enable PSA to make an informed decision on whether or not to sign the final draft collective agreement.
