

Associate Membership: Pension not the end of PSA participation

It is a common cause that union membership ceases when one retires or leaves employment, but not with the PSA. The PSA is more than just a union. It is a caring organisation that even caters for members beyond their working age. The PSA understands that there is still a need for engagement with former colleagues and comrades and thus Union deliberately provided for Associate (Pensioner) Membership in the *PSA Statute*.

Although the Associate (Pensioner) Membership status does not provide pensioner members with the rights of an employee as defined in the *Labour Relations Act*, such members will be entitled to all the benefits of PSA membership. Associate (Pensioner) members continue to engage in PSA activities such as attending intersectoral meetings, be elected as office bearers, represent members in disciplinary proceedings, and even recruit members. Further, **the membership fee is affordable and ranges between R38.73 per annum and R60.16 per month, depending on pensionable income.**

Members who are about to retire or are considering retirement are urged to approach the PSA Provincial Office for assistance with completing an Associate (Pensioner) Membership application form to ensure continuity of PSA membership.
