Update: DDPPs and Chief Prosecutors: Constitutional Court case judgement delivered

Members were informed that the Supreme Court of Appeal (SCA) ruled against the PSA to have all Deputy Directors of Public Prosecution (DDPPs) and Chief Prosecutors (CP) translated to LP 10 on the OSD scales. Members were also informed that the PSA decided to approach the Constitutional Court directly after the SCA judgment. The Constitutional Court has now ruled on the matter and has dismissed the PSA's application. The Court ruled that according to it, it does not believe that the case provided enough merits to approach the Constitutional Court directly. The judgement will be discussed with legal representatives to determine if there are any other means to assist DDPPs and CPs further.
