## What's happening in the Gauteng PHSDSBC Chamber

### **PMDS for 2020/21 for Gauteng Department of Health**

The Gauteng Department of Health has implemented PMDS payments for the 2020/21 financial year in full to all employees including those who qualified for performance bonuses. This matter was removed from the agenda of Chamber. If there are members of PSA who have not been paid pay progression or performance bonuses, they are free to contact the Johannesburg Provincial Office for information.

### **Gauteng Emergency Medical Services (EMS)**

The PSA has been trying to engage the provincial management of EMS regarding various issues affecting members. EMS Management has been arrogant in that they have failed to account for issues affecting members. The PSA demanded the intervention of the Provincial Chamber. A special chamber meeting to discuss all EMS issues will be held on 2 November 2023. Members will be informed of the outcome of the meeting.

### **Payment of Statutory Deductions (SANC, SACSSP, HCPSA)**

The Department of Health and the Department of Social Development reported that new statutory registration deductions will take place from members' salaries in October 2023 for the payment and renewal of Statutory Council registrations fees for the 2023/24 financial year. Members must please confirm that their deductions were made so that they are registered for the new financial year.

### **Payment of Uniform Allowance for Nursing Personnel**

The Department of Health and the Department of Social Development in Gauteng are expected to pay all Nursing Personnel R3153,23 for uniform allowance in terms of PHSDSBC 1/2023. This comes after the failure of the employer at national level to provide nursing uniforms. The timeframe set for both departments to pay nursing personnel uniform allowance is 30 November 2023.
