The PSA and SANBI have entered into a recognition agreement (*attached*). Founded on 7 July 1920 with a vision of protecting and promoting the rights and interests of workers, the PSA is proud of its many accomplishments in trade unionism and being instrumental in advancing the ever-changing labour movement. Employees who are yet to join the Union of Choice are urged to become part of the Union that specialises in nothing but workers' issues.
