Update: SAPC special Bargaining Forum meeting – 12 October 2023

Salary adjustment (COLA): 2024/25

The PSA presented its salary demand of 9.5% to the employer. The PSA informed the employer that as per mandate from members, the medical aid must be removed from the agenda and be discussed at a later stage. The employer tabled its offer of 3.5%. After many deliberations, the employer tabled its final offer that consists of the following.

- Salary increases of 4.25% across-the-board.
- Pay progression of 1.5% to all qualifying employees. Those below the 50th percentile will receive 1.5% and those above the 50th percentile will receive a 1.5% once-off cash amount payable in December 2023.

The PSA informed the employer that a mandate will be sought from members to either accept or reject this offer. Members are requested to forward their mandates to PSA shop stewards urgently. Mandates must be submitted by close of business on Friday, **20 October 2023**.
