SARS: PSA calls for inputs for upcoming salary negotiations for 2023/24-financial year

Members are aware that parties entered into a single-term agreement during last year's wage negotiations, which lapses on 31 March 2023. The new round of negotiations for the 2023/24-financial year is about to commence. The PSA, as a mandate-driven Union, invites members at SARS to submit inputs or proposals by 6 February 2023.

The PSA National Branch conducted a series of members' meetings as part of preparation for the next round of negotiations and has started receiving inputs from members. The PSA understands that some members may have missed these meetings and it will not be proper to continue with the consolidation of demands without affording them an opportunity to submit proposals. The submission of inputs is in terms of section 29(3) of the PSA Statute, which provides that the Branch must identify matters of mutual interest for negotiation purposes in the relevant bargaining forum.
