## Update: Outstanding 2021-salary increase

Members will recall that the PSA was the only Union that challenged the employer's failure to implement the third year of the 2019-wage agreement. The employer only partially implemented the agreed salary percentage, and still owes all employees 2.3%. The PSA referred the dispute to the High Court in Pretoria and the matter was argued in October 2022. Although the PSA made regular follow-ups with the High Court on when the judgement would be ready, the Court could still not give an indication when it would be ready.

Upon further investigation, the PSA was informed that the Judge who heard the matter was on long-term sick leave. The PSA has now been informed that the Judge has resumed her duties. The PSA will make further follow-ups shortly with the Judge's secretary on when the judgement could be expected as the Judge is back at work.

Members will be informed of developments.
