## PSA demands that salary negotiations for 2023/24 commence!

The current salary agreement expires on 31 March 2023. Since salary negotiations are generally protracted, the PSA has demanded that SARS immediately commences with salary negotiations for the upcoming financial year. Despite numerous written requests to SARS, it has to date not responded. The PSA has now demanded that should SARS immediately not respond, the PSA will have no alternative but to declare a dispute at the CCMA.

## Update 2021/22-wage dispute

Members will recall that the PSA was the only Union that challenged the employer's failure to implement the third year of the 2019-wage agreement. The employer only partially implemented the agreed salary percentage and still owes all employees 2.3%. The PSA referred the dispute to the High Court in Pretoria and the matter was argued in October 2022. The PSA has approached the High Court to determine when the judgement will be ready. The Judge's secretary informed the PSA that judgement is not yet ready. The PSA was reassured that the judgement will be sent to us as soon as it has been written by the honourable Judge.

Members will be informed of developments.
