## Feedback: CCMA facilitation meeting – 27 and 28 September 2023

Members will recall that a CCMA conciliation meeting was held on 18 September 2023. The PSA tabled a demand for a 12%-salary increase and the employer offered 3.5% for the 2023/24-financial year. Parties could not reach an agreement and were deadlocked. A facilitator was appointed by the CCMA to mediate the deadlock on 27 and 28 September 2023.

The employer revised its offer and improved it by 1%, which became 4.5% as a final offer. Labour revised the demand to 7.5%. Parties could not agree on the revised offer and demand placed on the table. The employer maintained that it does not have a mandate to improve the offer beyond 4.5%. Labour maintained that its demand can only be 7.5% and above. Parties deadlocked again and were directed to engage in picketing rules as per section 69 of the *Labour Relations Act 66, 1995*.

Members are requested to indicate whether they accept or reject the revised offer of 4.5% tabled by the employer. Members should send their mandates to <u>gracia.rikhotso@psa.co.za</u> or <u>zamani.dladla@psa.co.za</u> by 4 October 2023. A determination whether or not to embark on strike action will be made after the mandate from members and inputs from PSA management are received.

Members will be informed of developments.
