KwaZulu-Natal's 2023 matriculants clinched second spot, with a pass rate of 86.36% up from 83.0% in 2022. The Minister of Basic Education commended KwaZulu -Natal as the province with the most improved pass rate. This accomplishment reflects the dedication and commitment demonstrated by learners in their studies. Amidst the challenges faced by the KZN Department of Education, such as temporary disruption of the feeding scheme, and floods that damaged infrastructure, this pass rate further serves as testament to the unwavering commitment and sacrifices by educators. Their efforts contribute to the continuous improvement of the education standard, yielding significant returns on investment. The PSA commends learners and educators for achieving these successful outcomes. Additionally, the PSA acknowledges the crucial role played by parents and all stakeholders in contributing to this remarkable success.
