Provision of Uniform

In terms of PSCBC Resolution 3/1999, it is the employer's duty to provide uniform. PHSDSBC Resolution 1/2023 provides that the employer must provide uniform on 1 September of each year. The employer reported that the provinces had a challenge in terms of the specifications. The employer further reported that there was a Provincial Chief Financial Officers (CFO) meeting with the National Chief Financial Officer on 9 April 2024 to discuss the way forward. Organised Labour raised a concern that it seems that the employer will not be able to distribute uniforms in September 2024. Should the employer fail to provide the uniform as per the resolution, the PSA will demand that the uniform allowance continue. The employer was requested to provide a full report in a special task team meeting on a date to be confirmed.
