Update: CIPC - Conclusion of substantive wage agreement - 2025/26

Members will recall that in the previous *Informus* (copy available on the PSA's website or PSA Provincial Offices), it was reported that the ballot on wage negotiations for the 2025/26-financial year was open for voting from 1 to 4 August 2025. The PSA is pleased to inform members that 74% of eligible members participated in the process. Of those, 68% voted in favour of accepting the offer. Members' participation empowered the PSA to officially sign the 2025/26 Substantive Wage Agreement with the employer.

Key provision of agreement

- 6%-salary increase for all employees in the bargaining unit, effective 1 April 2025.
- 5%-increase to data allowance, effective1 September 2025.
- Medical-aid subsidy for pensioners pre-2023 the employer will contribute as follows (subject to a maximum):
 - o R1 810 with no dependents
 - o R3 620 with dependents, regardless of the number of dependents
 - If contribution is below R1 810 with no dependents, the employer will subsidise 75% of the actual premium paid, subject to a maximum of R1 810
 - o If the contribution is below R3 620 with dependents, regardless of the number of dependents, the employer will subsidise 75% of the actual premium paid, subject to a maximum of R3 620
