## Feedback: DLRRD Realignment Task Team meeting

Members were previously informed that during the Realignment Task Team meeting, the employer presented the Terms of Reference. The employer further indicated that the realignment of Deeds Registries has become necessary to align jurisdictional boundaries with provincial boundaries as outlined in the *Constitution of the Republic of South Africa* and municipal boundaries determined by the Demarcation Board. The objective is to enhance accessibility of deeds services for all citizens. At a subsequent meeting on 29 October 2025, the employer presented a project plan for realignment of the deeds registries.

The PSA noted the presentation by the employer and requested time to obtain inputs and a mandate from members and principals before endorsing the realignment project plan for deeds registries.
