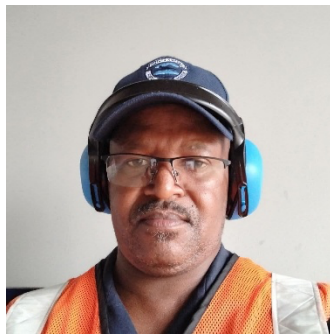


PSA mourns tragic passing of Eastern Cape Department of Transport members owing to Mthatha floods
