The training will cover critical areas including, but not limited to:

- Understanding your role and responsibilities as a shop steward
- Labour laws and workplace rights
- Grievance handling and dispute resolution
- Effective communication and negotiation
- PSA policies and procedures

In addition to the training programme, the Provincial Office is also creating mentoring and shadowing opportunities for shop stewards. This includes the chance to be mentored and to observe Labour Relations Officers in action during disciplinary hearings, conciliation, and arbitration proceedings. These practical exposures will provide valuable insight into workplace representation and strengthen your confidence in fulfilling your duties.
