## Victory for PSA: Continuation of GPG staff shuttle service (Pretoria to Johannesburg)

The PSA is pleased to inform members of a positive outcome following the Union's intervention regarding the discontinuation of the GPG staff shuttle service between Pretoria and Johannesburg.

Members will recall that the Gauteng Provincial Government (GPG) issued a circular, dated 4 August 2025, announcing the discontinuation of the staff shuttle service with effect from 4 September 2025. This decision was taken unilaterally and without prior consultation, despite the significant impact it would have had on employees who rely on this essential transport service.

The PSA immediately engaged the GPG, raising serious concerns about the lack of consultation and the adverse effects this decision would impose on members. As a result of these engagements and the PSA's firm stance in defense of workers' rights and interests, the GPG has withdrawn the circular and reversed its decision to discontinue the shuttle service.

The PSA is pleased to report that the GPG staff shuttle service will continue to operate as normal, ensuring that members are not disadvantaged by the previously announced termination. This victory reaffirms the PSA's commitment to protecting the rights and welfare of members and highlights the importance of collective engagement and meaningful consultation in decision-making processes affecting employees.

The PSA thanks all members for their support and vigilance and encourages members to continue reporting any workplace developments or decisions that may affect them.
