- Proven ability to represent members in grievances, disciplinary hearings, and must submit a portfolio of cases handled in the last 12 months.
- Strong knowledge of labour relations and key skills in negotiations and representation.
- Ability to recruit members – indicate the number of members recruited over the last 12 months in the application.
- A valid driver's license and a vehicle, which you are willing to use for PSA activities.
- Applicants must not be employed in a critical post.
