Victory for PSA member in Mpumalanga

Department of Health

A member, based in Gauteng, lodged a dispute through the PSA Provincial Office in Mpumalanga concerning his non-shortlisting for a promotional post at the Mpumalanga Department of Health. Despite submitting multiple written enquiries to the Department regarding the timing of interviews and the status of the post, the member received no response. Subsequently, a dispute was declared with the Public Health and Social Development Sectoral Bargaining Council (PHSDSBC) on the grounds of an alleged unfair labour practice relating to promotion. At arbitration, the employer raised a point *in limine*, arguing that the PHSDSBC lacked jurisdiction to hear the matter owing to the member not having registered a formal grievance. However, the PSA argued that according to the Grievance Rules, *the lodging of a grievance in such cases is optional; a grievance may be registered by an official, not mandatory*. The Commissioner accepted the PSA's argument and ruled that the PHSDSBC does have jurisdiction to hear the matter. The case will now proceed to arbitration, with a hearing date pending.
