Presentation of CCPMP Annual Report by Council

Council official, Mr Mpho Moseki, made a presentation on the legislative mandate, the vision, mission and values of Council, and the mandate of Council, which deal with matters that are regulated by uniform rules, norms, and standards that apply across the Public Service. Furthermore, matters that are assigned to the State as employer in respect of the Public Service and that are not assigned to the State as employer in any other sector. The report, which is obtainable from the Provincial Office, makes mention of this financial year's signed resolutions, 2024/25-meeting attendance statistics, agenda items discussed, capacity building for the Chamber, as well as the usage of dispute resolution in Mpumalanga.
