Victory for PSA member

The PSA recently secured another significant victory in defense of members' rights. A PSA member at the Department of Culture, Sports, and Recreation was charged with five counts of misconduct, ranging from sexual harassment, unacceptable behaviour, to carrying a firearm on the premises. Upon receiving the charges, the member approached the PSA for assistance with representation.

A local shop steward was promptly tasked to represent the member during the disciplinary hearing. Through diligent preparation and a strong presentation of the member's case, the shop steward successfully ensured that the matter was handled fairly.

As a result, the Chairperson issued a final written warning instead of a severe, punishable sanction. This outcome marks a victory for the PSA, where justice prevailed, and the member expressed great relief and appreciation for the Union's unwavering support and representation.
