Feedback: NLSA Joint Bargaining Forum Meeting - 1 August 2025

Members are aware that negotiations are underway at the National Library of South Africa after labour tabled their demands for cost-of-living adjustments and conditions of service. The employer committed during the meeting on 13 May 2025 to obtain a refreshed mandate after labour rejected the initial offer of 4.5%. Parties met on 1 August 2025, and the employer presented its final offer as follows:

- Employees on salary levels 1 to 3 salary adjustment of 5%.
- Employees on salary levels 4 to 6 salary adjustment of 4.8%
- Employees on salary levels 7 to 9 salary adjustment of 4.3%

The employer could not accede to all other demands, including a R600 increase in Housing Allowance, the re-instatement of 1% notch increase, performance bonus, and recognition of improved qualifications.

YOUR MANDATE IS REQUIRED!

PSA members must provide a mandate to ACCEPT or REJECT the offer.
