## **NSG draft International Relations and Cooperation policy**

The employer formally tabled the policy, which aims to enhance the NSG's approach to Africa and international relations and global engagements through partnerships that promote governance, capacity-building, and knowledge exchange. The purpose of this policy is, therefore, to establish a structured approach to managing Africa and international relations and partnership cooperation in the NSG by fostering meaningful cooperation that advances South Africa's developmental objectives and positions the NSG globally. The PSA noted the tabling of the long-awaited draft policy (attached) to solicit inputs from members.

## **NSG Employment Equity policy**

The employer formally tabled the policy, which aims to achieve equity in the workplace by promoting equality opportunities and fair treatment in employment through the elimination of unfair discrimination, and implementing affirmative action measures to redress disadvantages in employment experience by designated groups to ensure their equitable representation at all occupational levels.
