## Feedback: SAHPRA 5.5% revised wage offer - 10 September 2025

## **Urgent mandates requested: ACCEPT or REJECT 5.5%**

A feedback meeting was held with members on 10 September 2025 in respect of the 2025/26 CCMA wage dispute conciliation, which remained unresolved. Members were informed that the PSA moved down the demand from 10% to 7.5% and employer revised its offer from 5% to 5.5%. The Commissioner directed the PSA to make a referral requesting the set down for signing the picketing rules if it intends embarking on an industrial action.

Members were informed through an urgent report-back meeting on the same day, and outrightly rejected the revised offer, noting that their initial demand was 10% with a fall back to 8%. An electronic MS poll conducted also indicated that most employees who attended rejected the 5.5%.

Employees also indicated that they intend going on a full-blown strike rather than pickets, which have thus far proven to be ineffective, and understood the implications of the same on both parties. As a mandate-driven Union, the PSA will request its active members to indicate whether they **accept** or **reject** the final 5.5%-wage offer through the *attached* mandate form. The referral to the CCMA for picketing rules will be determined by the outcome of the mandating process.
