PSA progress at Special Investigating Unit: Recognition and organisational rights

The PSA remains a Union of Choice with a proven record in promoting and protecting the rights of its members in the workplace. The PSA is pleased to inform members of recent progress at the Special Investigating Unit (SIU), where the Union successfully recruited 381 members out of approximately 700 employees. Following this milestone, the PSA formally approached the SIU to request recognition and organisational rights in terms of section 21 of the *Labour Relations Act*. The SIU responded positively to this request by submitting a draft recognition agreement for engagement. A recognition agreement is a formal document where an employer acknowledges a trade union's right to represent and negotiate on behalf of its members.

Members are invited to review the draft recognition agreement (*attached*) and submit their inputs by no later than **31 January 2025** to Piet Maabane at *smaabane* @*siu.org.za*.

The PSA remains committed to keeping members informed of developments.
