## Update: WCBS salary negotiations 2025/26

The PSA is pleased to inform members that salary negotiations for 2025/26 have been concluded. Members will recall that a mandate was sought in response to the employer's offer of a 4.25% baseline increase and a 1.25% performance-based increase. The mandate resulted in a 53% vote in favour of the offer. With the PSA being an organisation that operates on the mandate of its constituents, the agreement has now been signed of (attached). The PSA thanks members for entrusting the Union with the weighted decision of securing their employment well-being.

The salary increase is set to be implemented along with the June-2025 salary run. Non-members are invited to join the PSA.
