Update: CSPS facilitation process - 6 May 2026

Remote Work Policy

Members will recall that the PSA previously reported that clause 17 of the General Public Service Sectoral Bargaining Council (GPSSBC) Governance Rules of Chambers was invoked after the employer bypassed consultation processes at the Policy Task Team. Members may refer to the previous *Informus* for further details.

The employer had submitted the Remote Work Policy for signature by the Secretariat of Police before finalising consultations with organised labour. During the facilitation process, parties agreed that the employer would share the approved Remote Work Policy and that the matter would be referred to the Task Team for further engagement on inputs submitted by labour. Subsequently, the Policy will be routed through the correct channels for further handling by the executive authority, after adoption by the Chamber. The PSA has urged the employer to expedite the sharing of the Policy to prevent further delays, particularly considering the growing financial strain on employees caused by continued price increases. Employees are increasingly burdened by rising travelling costs, which continue to negatively affect their disposable income and overall financial wellbeing. Members will be informed of developments.
