## College of Cape Town: Appointment of Administrator and dismissal of Principal

During the 2025/26 period, the PSA actively participated in the investigative processes concerning allegations of maladministration and corruption at the College of Cape Town. Following the conclusion of investigations conducted by the Student and Governance Support Team and supported by the Portfolio Committee, the Minister of Higher Education has appointed **Dr Robert Nkuna** as Administrator. His appointment is made in terms of *section 46(4) of the Continuing Education and Training Act, No 16 of 2006*, as published in *Government Gazette Vol 728, No 540160 of 17 February 2026*. The objective of the appointment is to ensure that the College of Cape Town is stabilised, and its affairs and operations are restructured.

Concurrent with this appointment, the services of the former Principal, Dr MM Muswaba, have been terminated following a finding of guilt on charges of gross misconduct. The PSA welcomes these developments as critical steps toward resolving long-standing governance challenges that have adversely affected members. The PSA calls upon the newly appointed Administrator to prioritise institutional stability and implement effective operational and governance reforms at the College. The PSA has urged the College to initiate engagement with staff and organised labour to outline the transitional roadmap and ensure transparency in the above-mentioned administrative process, with the aim of providing a clear way forward for all stakeholders. The PSA reaffirms the Union's commitment to safeguarding the rights and interests of members during this period of significant organisational change. PSA representatives remain actively engaged onsite and are ready to collaborate with the Administrator to restore sound governance practices, operational efficiency, and constructive labour relations at the College.
