Unilateral restructuring

Members were previously informed that the employer had commenced with a restructuring process arising from the NMOG process. At a previous meeting, the employer gave an update report on progress being made and it appears as if members are being engaged directly without labour being involved. Labour has consistently requested the employer to engage in the consultation process through the Chamber, but to no avail. The information informing the process was also requested and not received. A facilitation was held under the auspices of the General Public Service Sectoral Bargaining Council, and the employer gave a commitment to provide labour with the required documents before the end of March 2026 and convene a Special Chamber meeting for consultation before the second week of April 2026.

DPME Policies

It was noted that the Departmental Task Team is still engaging in consultation on the ICT Policy, Security Policy, Finance Policy, Budget Management Policy, and Asset Management Policy. Members are invited to submit any additional input they may still have on these Policies to the Branch Chairperson. The Task Team will continue with the consultation and consider the input by the PSA on the development of a Guideline for Service Delivery during Water Interruptions.
