Update: Eastern Cape PHSDSBC

Eastern Cape Chamber performance report (2025/26-financial year)

The meeting reviewed the performance of the Eastern Cape Chamber for the period 1 April 2025 to 31 March 2026. During the reporting period, six Chamber meetings and two special Chamber meetings were successfully held. In addition, nine caucus meetings took place, with the employer convening four and Labour five. A total of ten policies were tabled, of which four were adopted. The performance report, presented by the Chamber Secretary, was considered and adopted by labour and the employer. A capacity-building workshop on Resolution 4/2015, focusing on Chamber operations, was also conducted by the Chamber Secretary and was appreciated by both parties.

Annual General Meeting

An Annual General Meeting (AGM) was held on 10 April 2026, where the Chamber Secretary presented the draft PHSDSBC Annual Report for the 2025/26-financial year. The Report was reviewed, confirmed by labour and the employer, and subsequently adopted.
