The PSA Provincial Office: Pretoria extends sincere gratitude to all members in the Pretoria area for the unwavering support throughout 2025. Your commitment, participation, and belief in the work of the PSA continue to strengthen the collective voice in the public service.

Thanks to your support, the Pretoria Office achieved significant milestones during 2025. These include the PSA successfully hosting an Intersectoral Members' Meeting attended by more than 2 300 members, creating an important platform for engagement, unity, and collective reflection across sectors. The Office also proudly hosted the PSA's 105th Birthday Celebration, marking 105 years of service excellence, resilience, and advocacy for public servants. This milestone reaffirmed the PSA's long-standing commitment to defending workers' rights and improving conditions of service. The Office completed the move to the new building, reflecting a dedicated office space for the Provincial Office.

Beyond organisational events, the PSA Pretoria Office remained actively involved in community upliftment initiatives. During the year, it delivered three structures for Community Health Workers to utilise during patient investigations, thereby supporting frontline healthcare service delivery. In addition, school shoes were distributed to vulnerable learners, contributing to dignity, confidence, and access to education for children in need. The Office partnered with the various business partners to enhance service offerings to members and to ensure members receive more for their subscription than just assistance with individual matters and negotiations through collective bargaining processes.

When reflecting on these achievements, we are reminded that the strength of the PSA lies in the Union's members. The Office therefore calls on every member to play an active role in assisting the PSA to grow.
