Update to PSA members: Progressive engagement between the Registrar of Labour Relations and the PSA

The Public Servants Association (PSA) wishes to update members regarding the progressive engagement between the Registrar of Labour Relations and the PSA, on the Registrars intention to cancel the registration of the PSA as a trade union in terms of the *Labour Relations Act, 1995*.

The PSA and the Registrar met today and have engaged with a view to resolving the matters raised by the Registrar. The Union remains committed to addressing those matters constructively and in accordance with the provisions of the *LRA*. The Registrar has clarified that the PSA remains a genuine trade union, fully registered with full rights and obligations to represent its members, conduct collective bargaining, and exercise all rights conferred by the *LRA*.

Both the Registrar and the PSA stated that this matter will be resolved in the interest of members noting the significance and the role that the Union plays in public service. Members will be updated on developments. The PSA appreciates the continued trust, support, and commitment of the Union's members.
