Victory for PSA and members: PSA secures Court interdict against deregistration notice

The PSA is pleased to inform members of an important development concerning the attempted deregistration of the Union by the Registrar of Labour Relations. The PSA successfully obtained an interdict against the Registrar, preventing the implementation of the notice issued with the intention of deregistering the PSA. This is an important victory for the PSA and the Union's more than 250 000 members. The PSA remains a registered trade union and continues to protect and promote the rights and interests of public-sector employees. The PSA is committed to complying with legal obligations

What does PSA membership offer?

For only R119 per month, PSA membership provides access to a range of important services and benefits, including:

- Workplace representation: The PSA represents members in workplace disputes and assists members when their employment rights are threatened.
- Legal and labour assistance: Members have access to the PSA's professional labour-relations and legal resources. The PSA is one of the few trade unions that attends to individual disputes of members free of charge, subject to the applicable membership requirements.
- Collective bargaining: The PSA negotiates on behalf of members on matters including remuneration, working conditions, and other employment benefits through the relevant bargaining structures.
- Protection of employment benefits: The PSA advocates for and protects members' interests relating to benefits such as medical aid, pension schemes, housing subsidies, leave, and other conditions of service.
- Member benefits and discounts*: PSA members can access a range of partner benefits and special offers. *PSAClub* provides access to more than 2 000 deals, with discounts of up to 30% at participating retailers and other rewards, including grocery-related rewards and vouchers. **Discounts and rewards are subject to participating partners, applicable terms and conditions, and availability.*

PSA membership can pay for itself!

At R119 per month, PSA membership is an investment in members' employment protection and everyday savings. Members are encouraged to register on the *PSAApp/PSAClub* platforms and make full use of

the available partner discounts and special offers. The official *PSAApp* provides member registration, information dissemination, and access to the PSA's partner network. *PSAClub* offers substantial discounts at participating retailers. For example, if the discounts and rewards received during the month save you R119 or more, you have effectively recovered your monthly PSA membership fee. Don't only think of the R119 as a membership cost, use your PSA benefits and make your membership work for you!
