PSA National Women's Day event: 9 August 2026

The PSA will proudly commemorate National Women's Day 2026 by hosting an event that brings together members and stakeholders to celebrate and recognise the invaluable contributions of women in the workplace, communities, and society at large. The event will serve as a platform to celebrate women, reflect on the progress made towards gender equality and women's rights, and engage in meaningful discussions on challenges women continue to face in the workplace and beyond.

The event will be held in Pietermaritzburg in KwaZulu-Natal under the theme “**Advancing rights, justice, and action for all women**”, which seeks to highlight lived experiences of women in South Africa and calls on society to move beyond acknowledging women's rights and to take practical, measurable action that ensures every woman enjoys equality, dignity, protection, and access in leadership opportunities.

Date: Sunday, 9 August 2026

Time: 09:00 to 15:00

Venue: Shuku's Greenleaf Estate, Pietermaritzburg

Dress code: Semi-formal - Shades of cream, beige, and brown.

The programme will include various guest speakers, including business partners and PSA management, and entertainment. Lunch and drinks will be served with an opportunity for networking. The event will cater for **200 female attendees**. Tickets will be sold at **R20 each** as part of the PSA's corporate social investment programme. Tickets will be entered into a lucky draw where a delegate attending the event will walk away with a prize. During the event, the PSA will also make a donation to an orphanage in partnership with the KwaZulu-Natal Department of Social Development as part of efforts to drive positive societal change as a strong Union is not only measured by how it protects workers' rights but also how positively it impacts communities.

Transport has been arranged to facilitate attendance of invited members. One bus (65-seater) will depart from **Vryheid SAPS at 05:00** and will collect delegates at the following points: Ncome Prison, Nquthu Hospital, Dundee Shell Garage, Gelincore Total Garage, and Ladysmith Post Office and will proceed to the venue.

One minibus (30 passengers) will depart from PSA Durban office , corner Gadner and Smith Streets at **07:00** travelling directly to Pietermaritzburg. No subsistence and travel claims will be considered.
