Important member update: De-linking of mobile clinics (Amajuba District)

The KwaZulu-Natal Department of Health, Amajuba District Office, convened a consultation meeting on the de-linking of mobile clinics on 31 March 2026 at Madadeni Regional Hospital. The purpose of the meeting was to engage with employees who may be affected by the proposed de-linking of mobile clinics from Madadeni Regional Hospital to Dannhauser Community Health Centre (CHC).

During the meeting, the Human Resources Manager of Madadeni Regional Hospital informed mobile clinic staff members about the number of clinics and personnel to be transferred to Dannhauser CHC. It was confirmed that one mobile clinic, along with three staff members, will be transferred. The affected staff complement includes one operational manager and two clinical nurse practitioners.

Staff members were invited to volunteer for the transfer to Dannhauser CHC. In the event that there are no volunteers, the Human Resources component will conduct individual consultations with affected employees regarding the transfer process. During these consultations, employees will have the right to representation by their respective unions. At present, no formal criteria have been established to identify staff members for transfer should there be no volunteers.

Employees were given an opportunity to raise questions and engage with management from Madadeni Regional Hospital and Dannhauser CHC regarding the de-linking process. Organised labour was also afforded an opportunity to engage with staff. During this session, employees raised issues they would like organised labour to present to management at the next task team meeting. Notably, one operational manager volunteered for transfer to Dannhauser CHC.
