## Victory for PSA member

The PSA in Limpopo successfully defended a member at Statistics South Africa in a complex disciplinary hearing involving seven allegations, including serious charges of sexual harassment, humiliation, insulting staff, and abuse of power. At the inception of the hearing, the PSA challenged several allegations, resulting in one being withdrawn. The member pleaded not guilty to the remaining six charges. The case was extensive, involving testimony from some twelve witnesses.

The PSA provided strong representation throughout, including detailed closing arguments. After full consideration, the Chairperson found the member not guilty on all charges. This outcome demonstrates the PSA's commitment to protecting workers from unfair labour practices and highlights the importance of Union representation.

The PSA will do everything in the Union's power to protect members' rights and promote their interests as practicing service excellence is an important value of the PSA.
