

PSA mourns tragic passing of member



The PSA has learnt with profound shock and sadness of the tragic passing of the Union's member, **Mr Moses Thwala**, a School Health Professional Nurse at Nhlazatshe No 6 Community Health Centre.

According to information received, Mr Thwala was shot by an unknown assailant whilst sleeping at his home on 22 July 2026. The circumstances surrounding this senseless and barbaric killing remain under investigation. Mr Thwala dedicated his life to serving communities through the public healthcare sector. His death is a great loss to his family, colleagues, patients, and the broader public service fraternity.

The PSA extends sincere condolences to the Thwala family, friends, colleagues, and all those affected by this tragic loss. May they find strength, comfort, and courage during this painful period of mourning. The PSA condemns this brutal act of violence and calls upon law enforcement authorities to conduct a thorough investigation to ensure that the perpetrators are identified, arrested, and brought to book. Justice must prevail, and those responsible for this barbaric murder must be held accountable.

The PSA takes this opportunity to honour the valuable contribution that Mr Thwala made to public service and the healthcare profession. His commitment to improving the lives of others will be remembered with gratitude and respect.

The **memorial service** will be held at **Embhuleni Hospital** on **31 July 2026**. The **funeral service** will take place on **1 August 2026** (venue TBC).

The PSA joins the family and community in mourning the loss of Mr Moses Thwala. May his soul rest in eternal peace.
