## Feedback: Meeting with National Director of Public Prosecutions - 4 June 2026

The PSA, led by the Union's General Manager, convened a meeting with the National Director of Public Prosecutions (NDPP). The engagement provided the NDPP an opportunity to present his vision for the NPA and to outline strategic priorities aimed at strengthening the institution since assuming office five months ago. Amongst priorities highlighted was the corporatisation of the NPA.

The discussion provided a valuable platform for open dialogue, with particular emphasis on the safety of Prosecutors. The PSA raised concerns that inadequate protection undermines the NPA's ability to achieve its strategic objectives. The NPA acknowledged the importance of these concerns and committed to strengthening safety measures for Prosecutors. Both parties agreed to work together to ensure that the Employee Protection Policy is finalised promptly and to maintain ongoing engagements to strengthen relations.
