Bursary Policy

Members are aware that the National Treasury has an existing bursary in place. In tabling this draft amended policy, the employer indicated that a need has arisen to amend certain sections to keep up with new developments. The purpose of this bursary policy is to set out the mandatory framework and guidelines that govern the implementation and management of the National Treasury Bursary Policy and to provide a structured holistic approach for the awarding of bursaries by the National Treasury to eligible internal employees and external students, in line with government's commitment to skills development and transformation goals. The proposed changes are indicated in red for ease of reference. The PSA noted the tabling and urged the employer to urgently set down a date for the Departmental Task Team to discuss this policy.
