The employer tabled a presentation outlining the research that was conducted on the benchmarking of the heritage site as well as the initial plans that was developed to develop the Union Buildings accordingly. They have outlined the different zoning areas, which will accommodate tourism, and other activities on the current premises of the Union Building. The employer further indicated that the plans are still initial plans.
