CCPLP Annual General Meeting

The Annual General Meeting of the Coordinating Chamber for the Public Service Coordinating for Limpopo Province (CCPLP) was held on 19 August 2026. The Chamber Secretariat presented the CCPLP Annual Report for the 2025/26-financial year. The Report included an overview of attendance at Chamber meetings during the report period. It was reported that the PSA attended 88% of meetings and referred 67% of cases during the 2025/26-financial year. The Report indicates that the PSA referred the highest number of disputes followed by Hospersa and Nehawu. Although the PSA is the highest in referring disputes, the Report indicates that most employees are referring disputes themselves without the assistance of unions and this led to referring cases out of jurisdiction. This shows that most employees still do not belong to a union and are paying agency fees.

Determination: Vote weights for Chamber

The PSA, acting together with NPSWU, represents 13 075 members and holds a vote weight of 12.78%. This places the PSA in third position amongst unions represented in the Chamber and confirms the PSA's status as a leading Union. Shop stewards, structure members, and members are encouraged to continue supporting the PSA's growth by recruiting new members and strengthening the Union's representation.

Election: Chairperson and Vice-Chairpersons

In terms of PSCBC Resolution 2/2005, parties are required to elect a Chairperson and Vice-Chairpersons annually. The following office bearers were elected for the 2026/27-financial year:

- Mr T Monyai (Organised labour) - Chairperson
- Mr M Maseko (Employer) – Vice-Chairperson.

This is to ensure that the Chamber deals with matters within its jurisdiction and does not deviate from its mandate.
