## Recruitment drive: PSA Pretoria Office pushes towards 50 000 members

As part of ongoing efforts to strengthen the PSA and expand representation in the public service, the PSA Provincial Office in Pretoria invites members to participate in a special recruitment competition. This initiative presents an opportunity for members to contribute to the continued growth of the PSA whilst qualifying for attractive rewards during the **competition period of 15 June 2026 to 30 June 2026**.

### Eligibility

The competition is open to all PSA members in the Pretoria region, including Pretoria, Mabopane, Ga-Rankuwa, Bronkhorstspuit, and Cullinan.

### How to participate

Members are encouraged to introduce colleagues to the benefits and services offered by the PSA and assist them in joining the Union. Members will also qualify to be paid an honorarium for each new member recruited equivalent to one month's membership fee.
