## Hay Grade matter: SARS application to petition Labour Court judgement

The PSA wishes to inform members that the South African Revenue Service (SARS) has filed an application to petition the Labour Court judgement that was granted in favour of the PSA in the Hay Grade matter.

The PSA is extremely disappointed by the decision of SARS to continue litigating instead of complying with the judgement. This is particularly concerning given that the Presiding Judge expressly criticised SARS for electing to litigate to avoid its obligations to employees and further issued a costs order against SARS.

Despite this setback, the PSA is committed to defending the rights and interests of members. The PSA will continue to exhaust all legal avenues to ensure that the Labour Court judgement is upheld and that members receive the justice they deserve.

The PSA calls on members to remain patient and united during this process. The PSA acknowledges the frustration caused by the continued delays but assures members that the Union will not relent and will keep members informed of all material developments as the matter progresses.
