SASSETA wage demands for 2026/27-financial year

The PSA, as the recognised trade union representing employees of the SASSETA, has tabled demands as follows:

Term of agreement

Single-term agreement.

Percentage increase

That the percentage increase be 7%, based on inflation, medical inflation, other items not in the CPI basket, and noting that SASSETA employees have been receiving less than market-related increases.

Any other matter

Parties have agreed to commence with salary negotiations through a special Labour Management Forum (LMF) meeting on 13 April 2026.

The PSA will continue to protect collective bargaining as a tool to improve the conditions of service of members. Feedback will be provided to members after the above-mentioned meeting.
