- PHSDSBC Resolution 3/2019 – Amendments to an Agreement on Payment of Annual Statutory Registration Fees in Respect of Health and Social Development Professionals.

Payment of Annual Statutory Registration fees: Health and Social Development Professionals - Resolution 3/2019

According to the Resolution, it was agreed that the employer will introduce a payment mechanism for the registration fees by means of Persal for statutory bodies as mandatory in the Health and Social Development Sector. The employer shall deduct the registration fee by means of a one-month deduction within such a year for registration and to make payment to the SANC. According to the employer and the SANC, there are employees who had not paid the registration fees for the past few years, and that causes a challenge for the new registration of these professionals. The employer has been requested to provide a name list for those affected to the next Chamber meeting. All PSA members who received letters from the employer indicating that they have been deregistered by the SANC owing to non-compliance in the past year/s are requested to submit their names to PSA's Nelspruit Office with such proof.
