The overall winner will be chosen from these finalists and will be announced in November 2014. Each finalist will win a R2 000-cash prize, a PSA-branded clothing item and a framed certificate.

The overall winner will also win a prize sponsored by *Rennies Travel* consisting of a local weekend holiday package for two people, with flights, accommodation (dinner, bed and breakfast) and car hire valued at R15 000!
