

The *Clips&Caps* project that began in 2020 as part of the PSA's centenary initiatives, saw PSA members, staff, and structures collecting various types of plastic bottle caps and bread tags for recycling. These items were then exchanged for brand new wheelchairs in cooperation with waste management company, *Interwaste*.

The PSA was inspired to provide more people with the gift of mobility and has, to date, donated 16 wheelchairs to deserving beneficiaries across the country. Following the success of this initiative, the PSA decided to continue with the Clips&Caps project and encourages members, shop stewards, and structures to continue participating in this deserving project.

Plastic bottle caps and bread tags that are collected can be delivered to all PSA Provincial Offices for further processing. The project will run until August 2023.

The following types of plastic bottle tops are accepted:

- Milk bottle tops
- Cold drinks bottle tops
- Sta-soft bottle tops
- Bottled water tops
- Cooking-oil tops
- Mayonnaise bottle tops

The following indicates the quantities required to secure ONE WHEELCHAIR:

Bottle tops: 450 kg Bread tags: 50 kg

Shop stewards are requested to assist by submitting collected clips and caps to PSA Provincial Offices.
